

Corporate Sailing/Fishing Day

About the Fishing/Sailing adventure I am proposing the following:

- Buses collect group at approximately 8.00am, group should be divided into those fishing and those sailing. We would like to get the fishermen away first as there is only a small departure area.
- A safety run down will be undertaken prior to departure
- Light snacks and drinks will be provided on all boats for morning tea
- The group will meet at a pre organized location at 12.00 for lunch, this will consist of either a 'sand bar lunch' or staying out over the fishing areas.
- Those wishing to exchange and try some fishing will organize themselves during the lunch.
- Boats will return at 4.30pm approx. to be collected by the buses for return to accommodations.

Inclusions:

- Bottled water
- Soft Drinks
- Light and mid strength beer, 6 cases - mixed brands
- Wine – mixed white and red – 12 bottles
- Morning tea - Fresh fruit, cheeses, dips, crackers etc
- Marinated chicken pieces – lunch choice
- Minute steaks – lunch choice
- Freshly cooked fish – this is why we want the fishermen out first!
- Salads
- Bread
- Packets of chips for snacking on

They will need to bring with them:

- Hats
- Sunglasses
- Cameras
- Sunscreen

- Towel – for those who want to partake in water activities on the catamarans

The boats will be made up with the following numbers:

- Group of 12 and group of 21 on each of the catamarans under sail - very relaxed
- 2 Groups of 8 on 2 fishing vessels
- Group of 11 on 3rd fishing vessel

As you can see there is plenty of room for people to enjoy a mix of activities on the day – so a good day should be had by all. Toilet facilities are available on the catamarans.
